

# SEX & GENDER RESEARCH SUPPORT SERVICE OPTIONS

Listed below are services available\* for hire from the SGRS.

## Pre-funding

- **Review the project** (e.g. proposal, questionnaire, NOI) and provide feedback on the integration of sex and gender throughout
- **Provide a Confirmation of Review letter** indicating our role as a consultant for sex and gender considerations in the project

## Post-funding

### Implementation Phase:

- **Consults:** Attend project team meetings (either in person or via teleconference), provide expertise and critical insights on sex and gender issues and direction for integration into the project's research, design and methods
- **Academic literature scan:** conduct a scan to identify sex and gender issues that are relevant to your research (limited to a Medline OR PubMed search, first 25 articles in last 15 years)
- **Produce a thematic analysis:** Using the literature scan create a thematic analysis report of key themes, findings, gaps pertaining to sex and gender components of the study
- **Scoping review:** conduct a scoping review of the literature to map the knowledge landscape around sex and gender issues pertaining to research project

### Evaluation & Analysis Phase

- **Findings/analysis feedback:** critically appraise and provide feedback on sex and gender considerations in the project's findings/analyses
- **Develop primary data tools**
- **Data collection:** Collect qualitative/quantitative data and recruit participants
- **Sex and gender data analysis:** analyze data collected in sex and gender subgroup (e.g. code qualitative data using NVivo, analyze quantitative data SPSS), present findings as thematic reports and/or statistical tables/figures
- **Sex and gender database analysis:** conduct analyses of sex and gender issues using

pre-existing health services databases (e.g. ICES data), or pre-existing project data

## Knowledge Translation (KT) & Dissemination Phase

- **KT strategy and feedback:** Provide assistance and feedback on the KT tools and dissemination plans, tailor these to the respective audiences
- **Contribute to publications:** as co-authors assist with academic publications on the project's sex and gender related findings, co-produce publications on the process and methodology of the project's sex and gender component
- **Promotion of project within Women's Xchange networks:** Publicize the study, and the sex and gender components of the study at our events, through online communication (e.g. articles in WCRI/WCH newsletters, on the Women's Xchange twitter and website)
- **Develop dissemination tools for an academic audience:** state of the literature update pages on sex and gender considerations in the existing literature
- **Develop dissemination tools for frontline practitioners and knowledge users:** for instance updates on the project's sex and gender related findings, practice implications, guidelines
- **Create KT materials for dissemination tailored with a sex and gender lens:** infographics, pamphlets, etc. with a sex and gender approach
